They sold Joseph to the Ishmaelites for twenty pieces of silver. Genesis 37: 28

AND

*Saul discussed his intention of killing David with his son Jonathan
and with all his servants. 1 Samuel 19: 1*

AND

*Satan answered the Lord and said, 'Is it for nothing that
that Job is God-fearing...put forth your hand and touch anything
he has and surely he will blaspheme you to your face.' Job 1: 9, 11*

AND

*So the chief priests and the Pharisees convened the Sanhedrin
and said, 'What are we going to do? This man is performing many signs.
If we leave him alone, all will believe in him, and the Romans will
come and take away both our land and our nation.' John 11: 47-48*

C. What does Almighty God promise for those who are careful to listen to Him with consistency?

*Trust in the LORD with all your heart and lean not on your own understanding;
in all your ways submit to him, and he will make your paths straight. Proverbs 3: 5-6*

will **guard your hearts** and your minds in Christ Jesus. Philippians 4: 7
